ORGANIZATIONAL CONTEXT

The United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) is the United Nations agency responsible for human settlements, mandated to promote socially and environmentally sustainable towns and cities, with the goal of providing adequate shelter for all; within the overall objective of the United Nations to reduce poverty and promote sustainable development. The details of the Habitat Agenda, Global Programmes and the Mandate are available in the global web site at www.unhabitat.org and the Sri Lankan web site at www.unhabitat.lk.

UN-Habitat operations in Asia include activities in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Indonesia, Iran, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines and Sri Lanka, under supervision of the Regional Office for Asia and Pacific in Fukuoka Japan.

Since its inception in 1978, UN-Habitat has been closely working with the Government of Sri Lanka and implemented projects and programmes under the themes of, (a) Environment and climate change; (b) Post-disaster recovery and reconstruction; (c) Land and housing; (e) Disaster Risk Management; (f) Urban planning and governance; (g) Pro-poor settlement upgrading; (h) Water and sanitation; (i) Community infrastructure; and (j) Social inclusion.

UN Habitat operates in several provinces of Sri Lanka, namely; Central and Uva provinces in conducting several medium to large scale housing and infrastructure projects involving civil construction through community participatory process, in addition to emergency response projects.

The project intends to increase access to sustainable, safe water and adequate sanitation for poor and vulnerable communities; reduce the prevalence of Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)-related diseases through the promotion of personal hygiene, environmental practices and provision of infrastructure; improve the water and sanitation services at preventive and curative primary health care facilities; improve agricultural practices and extension services to enhance productivity for upliftment of rural and estate communities; and reduce post-harvest losses, increase food security and household income. The Project will be implemented in five (5) Divisional Secretariat (DS) divisions, namely Nuwara Eliya, Walapane, Hanguranketha, Kothmale and Ambagamuwa in the Nuwara Eliya District within Central Province; and six (6)

Divisional Secretariat divisions, namely, Mahiyanganaya, Rideemaliyadda, Haldummulla, Badulla, Bandarawela and Welimada Badulla District within Uva Province.

This vacancy announcement aims to invite persons with specific qualifications, skills and, experience to implement water supply and sewage systems, as well as community-driven housing projects, in plantation areas.

FUNCTIONS/KEY RESULTS EXPECTED

He / she will undertake providing engineering and site management inputs in the implementation of construction projects and be responsible for the site management, quality assurance, timely delivery, construction safety, ensuring administrative controls of the field staff, maintain good relationships with stakeholders including beneficiary communities and neighborhoods and providing leadership to the field staff

In particular, he / she will undertake the following tasks under the direct supervision of Deputy Project Manager,

Duties assigned:

- Oversee project activities and provide guidance and information to communities and CBOs in the preparation of technical designs, BoQ, technical specifications, and construction schedules.
- Provide technical guidance to communities and CBOs on appropriate construction standards;
- Conduct feasibility studies in the project locations in collaboration with the relevant authorities, and prepare reports for each location.
- Provide technical information, site data, and any other information required by consultants for the water supply and sewerage system.
- Supervise & guide Technical Officers, Assistant Engineers and Community Mobilization Assistant
- Review and approve design, BoQ, cost estimate, contract documents;
- Supervise the compliance of the project activities with the objectives and strategy of the project and ensure timely delivery of activities at the field level;
- Identify gaps in technical issues and recommend technically suitable rectifications;
- Develop training/ awareness plans for local government officers, CBOs, and communities in disaster resilience, alternative construction techniques, hygiene practices and maintenance of the project activities;
- Attending site progress/review meetings in a periodical with the project stakeholders;
- Liaise with agencies with similar mandate and advocate standard procedures
- Supervise and monitor construction activities
- Monitor the flow of funds and utilization of the grants
- Prepare inputs to the required progress reports, project performance reports, and the project terminal report;

Undertake any additional tasks, which are deemed appropriate in carrying out the above, in assisting the Deputy Project Manager.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education

Candidates shall have a Civil Engineering Degree or directly related field is preferred, from a university recognized by the University Grants Commission in Sri Lanka. Membership in a professional Engineering body will be advantageous

Work Experience

Work experience in development, emergency relief, or disaster reconstruction in the public and private sectors, local governments, non-governmental organizations, or international organizations is preferred in the above-mentioned relevant field. Applicants should have a strong commitment to participatory processes, knowledge transfer, a willingness to work in a team, and excellent coordination and communication skills..

Experience within the UN system and familiarity with UN rules, regulations and procedures related to field level project implementation are advantageous.

Required Years of Work Experience:

With a university degree and at least 6 years of work experience, particularly in water supply, sewerage, and community-driven housing projects,

Local knowledge of areas assigned and knowledge in English and the local languages will be advantageous.
